The following items are included in the fee when you choose Take A Vow Celebrants:

Before the Day

- ✓ All legal requirements depending on your personal history and situation including Notice of Intent to Marriage Form (NOIM) and instructions on how to complete the form
- ✓ Declaration of No Legal Impediment to Marriage
- ✓ Ceremony guidelines and assistance on forming your vows/ceremony
- ✓ I will assist you in compiling a meaningful ceremony by offering sample texts and advice to assist you
- ✓ 1 x Rehearsal on site where the ceremony will be held

On the Day

- ✓ PA system with microphone for celebrant and reader, for ceremony
- ✓ In accordance with the Celebrant Code of Practice, I always arrive at least 20 minutes before the start of the ceremony or at a mutually agreed time
- ✓ I dress in accordance with your selected ceremony style
- ✓ I respect the privacy and confidentiality of the parties
- ✓ A presentation copy of your ceremony printed on quality paper
- ✓ Your official marriage certificate printed on quality paper

After the Ceremony in Following Days

- ✓ Complete all legal requirements, including paying the fee to formally register the marriage with Department of Births Deaths and Marriages
- ✓ Keep all records in accordance with the Marriage ACT of 1961
- ✓ Provide a feedback form
